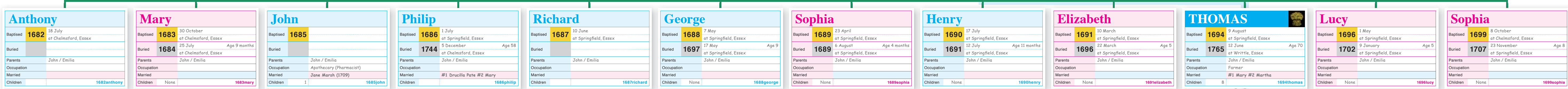


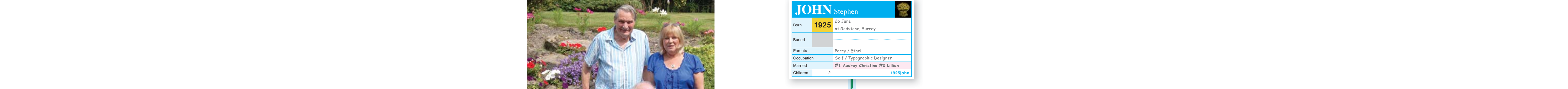
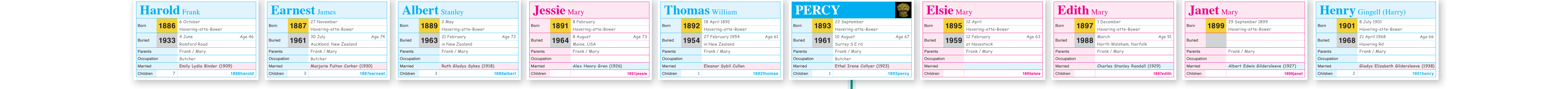
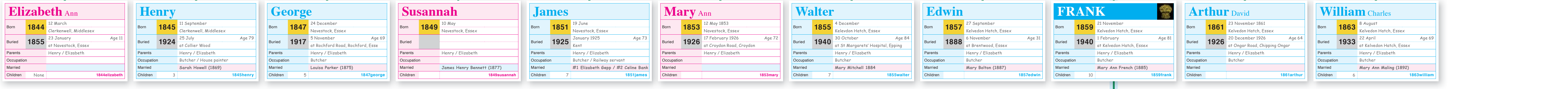
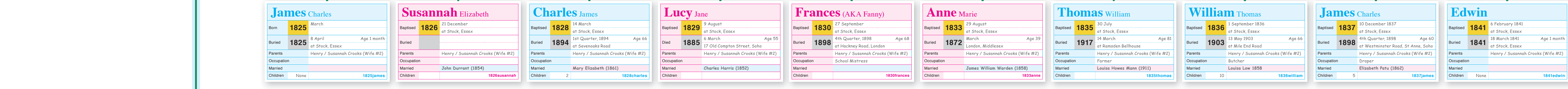
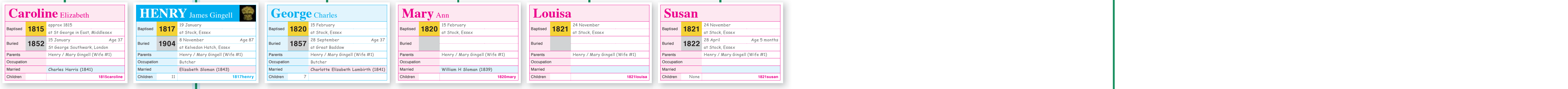
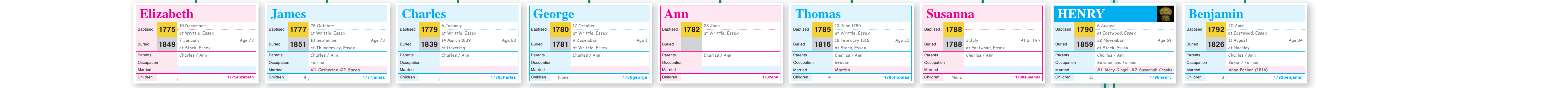
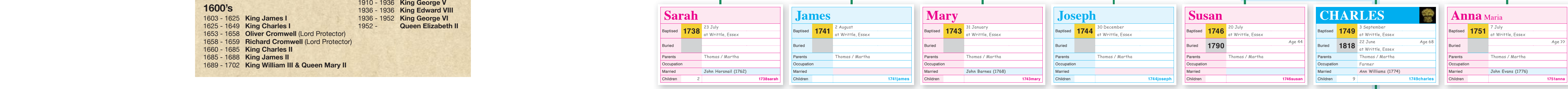
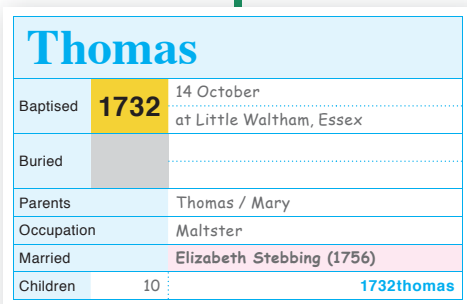
1679 "The Knightbridge Library is the historic library of mainly sixteenth and seventeenth century Protestant writings bequeathed to the Parish Church of St. Mary the Virgin, now Chelmsford Cathedral, by John Knightbridge. It is the Cathedral's duty to maintain and preserve this collection of books and make books from the collection available to scholars"



Argent, on two Bars Sable, three Garbs Or, is born by the Name of *Knightbridge*, and was granted to *Anthony Knightbridge* of *Chelmsford* in the County of *Essex*, and to *Richard, John and George*, his Brethren, Sons of *John Knightbridge* of *Chelmsford* aforelaid, by Sir *Edward Bylde*, Clarenieux, in *May 1663*, in the 14th Year of King *Charles II.*
